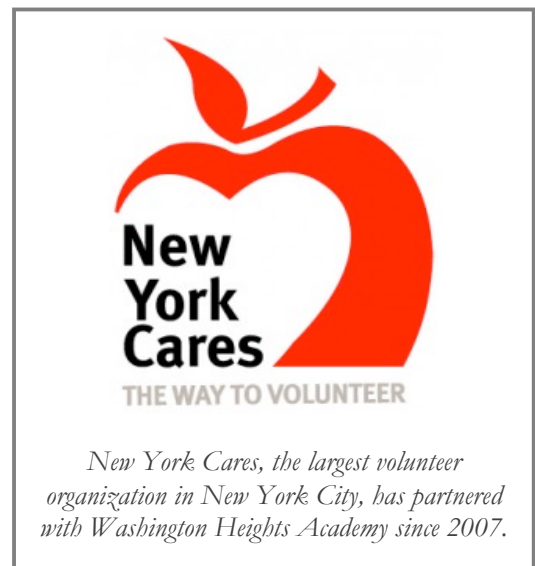
WHA News: December 2017
